Minutes of the ICTV Plenary Session 11:30 Tuesday 29 July 2014 Room 513B, Palais des Congrès de Montréal, Montreal, Canada

Chair: Professor Eric Carstens (President of ICTV)

Attendance: 32 people.

The chairman welcomed people to the meeting.

1. President's Report

The chairman summarised the activities of ICTV in the period 2011-2014 by presenting:

- a) A list of Executive Committee (EC) members and life members
- b) A list of the EC meetings held
- c) A list of the websites and newsletters associated with ICTV
- d) A list of references to ratification votes on taxonomic proposals
- e) A list of references to changes to the Taxonomic Code (2013) and the Statutes (2013 and 2014). The 2014 changes to the Statutes allow for the appointment of a third secretary responsible for virus data and for some re-structuring of the remits of the Subcommittees
- f) A list of organisations who were thanked for their financial support
- g) A summary of the contents of the Ninth Report, which appeared in print late in 2011.

The chairman explained that these activities represented a tremendous amount of work by the members of the EC and he asked the meeting to join him in thanking everyone for their hard work. He also acknowledged the effort of many other virologists who participate in Study Groups and prepare proposals as well as those who act as national representatives.

2. Reports of the Subcommittees

Brief reports were presented by the Chairs of the six Subcommittees summarising progress during 2011-2014 and some issues that were currently being discussed and carried forward.

- a) Viruses of Fungi presented by Said Ghabrial; the subcommittee is also responsible for viruses of algae and protists
- b) Viruses of Invertebrates presented by Peter Krell
- c) Viruses of Plants presented by Hélène Sanfaçon
- d) Viruses of Vertebrates presented by Andrew Davison
- e) Rob Lavigne, chair of the Prokaryotic Virus Subcommittee was unable to be present but the President noted that the Subcommittee had been very active in preparing proposals during the last 3 years
- f) Virus Data Subcommittee presented by Elliot Lefkowitz; this included a survey of the web sites of ICTV, particularly highlighting the ways in which the current taxonomy can be accessed and the recent addition of historical data allowing examination of changes in taxonomy from the first Report (1971) onwards. He explained that the EC was now investigating ways to make ICTV Reports available online with open-access and with a continuous system of updating.

3. Elections to the Executive Committee

The President presented to the meeting a list of Subcommittee (SC) chairs who had been appointed by the EC to serve for the period 2014-2017:
